Howard R. Northrup, 92, of 100 Rosh Road Sayre, PA passed away Monday morning, August 20, 2018 at the Sayre Personal Care Center. Howard was born in Monroeton, PA on February 4, 1926 one of seven children to Henry and Susie Isbell Northrup. As a child, Howard loved fishing with his older brother, Henry. Howard met the former Marjorie Davidson at a dance and they were married for 68 years. When Howard was nineteen years old he served with the U.S. Naval Airforce during World War II in the Pacific region and Japan. Howard had a fascinating career with E.I.
