Hugh Edward Cole, 69, of Ghent Hill, Sheshequin Township, PA passed away Tuesday, July 30, 2013 at his home following declining health. Hugh was born in Waverly, NY on July 29, 1944 the son of Earl Edward Cole and Maude “Edna” North Cole. He was a graduate of Athens High School class of 1962 and later served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1963 to 1967 during the Viet Nam War.
