



Jack P. Lejedal

November 16, 1924 - February 15, 2015

Jack P. Lejedal, 90, formerly of Mechanic St. Towanda, PA passed away Sunday morning, February 15, 2015 at the Personal Care Home of Memorial Hospital, Towanda where he had been a resident for the past six years. Jack was born at the family homestead on Mechanic Street in Towanda on November 16, 1924 one of eight children to Leonard Herman Lejedal and Flossie Place Lejedal. He left high school in Towanda to serve in the U.S. Navy during World War II in Panama, Galapagos Islands, Bora Bora, Society Islands, Tahiti, Brisbane (Australia) and the Philipines. Following the end of the war, he returned home to graduate from Towanda High School with the class of 1946. On March 31, 1951, Jack married the former Dorothy Mae Stewart at SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Towanda with the Rev. Augustine P. Conniff as celebrant. On April 11, 1951, Jack was ordered to return to active duty with the Navy and served during the Korean War receiving his honorable discharge on May 1, 1952. Jack began his career with Sylvania Electric in Towanda in 1955 remaining there for 32 years until his retirement on July 31, 1986. In 1977 he was the honored recipient of the Leslie H. Warner Technical Achievement Award by Sylvania Electric. While working at Sylvania, Jack also operated his own radio and television repair business in Towanda. He was a member of the former Towanda Ambulance Association for many years and was one of the original eight members that initiated the Emergency Medical Technician Program in 1972. Jack was a life member of Towanda American Legion Post No 42 for 70 years and the post's

World War II Last Man's Club. He was a life member of Beirne-Webster VFW Post No. 1568, Towanda, a life member of the Naiad Linta Fire Company and the Franklin Steam Engine Company in Towanda and was a charter member of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Lodge No. 2191, Towanda. He was a member of the GTE Sylvania Quarter Century Club and a former member of the Towanda Country Club. On April 15, 1981, Jack was awarded the Bradford County Certificate of Appreciation for 25 years of active community service by the Bradford County Commissioners. In earlier years, Jack enjoyed fishing, hunting, playing golf and cards.
