On August 26, 2025, the Lord called Jack W. Robinson age 69 of Stevensville PA, formerly of Wyalusing, to continue his walk with Him.

Jack was born in Towanda Mills Hospital on June 4, 1956 and was the son of the Late Gene and Eleanor Robinson of Wyalusing.

Jack graduated from the Wyalusing Area High School 1974. He began work at Hoovers Sawmill and later Masonite in Wysox, before working for the USPS as a substitute rural mail carrier New Albany and retired from P&N Packing after 41 years of service in July of 2018.

Jack enjoyed coaching the Camptown Little League Cobras baseball team, snowmobiling, hunting, fishing, riding motorcycle, working with bees, camping, his cats KK and Mamma kitty, and being with friends.
