James E. Allen, 89, of 18 Fall Run Road, Wysox, PA passed away peacefully early Saturday morning, December 20, 2014 at his home. James was born in Towanda, PA on February 3, 1925 the son of Web and Crystal Shults Allen. He was a graduate of Towanda High School class of 1943. He was a veteran of World War II having served in the U.S. Army at the D- Day Invasion at Normandy and was a veteran of the Korean War. Following completion of his military service, James returned home and attended technical school in Philadelphia, PA. On December 10, 1948 he married the former Janet Newell at her parent's family homestead and farm in Wysox. James worked on the Newell Family farm and also owned and operated Allen's Carpet Installation business in Wysox for many years until his retirement.

He was a member of the Wysox Presbyterian Church, Towanda American Legion Post No. 42, Beirne-Webster VFW Post No. 1568, Towanda, Towanda Elks Lodge No. 2191, Towanda Lions Club and the Quarry Glen Club. James loved playing golf and was a member of the Towanda Country Club, the Nichols Country Club and the Eagles Mere Country Club. He is survived by his devoted wife with whom he recently celebrated 66 years of marriage, Janet Newell Allen, a sister and brother-in-law, Shirley and Lewis Baton of Groton, CT, sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Peggy and Cal Shipman of Hideaway Lakes, TX, several nieces, nephews, cousins and many good friends. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by infant brothers, Carl and Palmergrant Allen, brothers, Philip "Pooch" Allen who was listed as

missing in action during World War II, and Steven Allen, and a sister, Sandra Taylor.

The funeral service will be held Tuesday, December 23, 2014 at 2:00 p.m. at the Wysox Presbyterian Church with Rev. Jira Albers and Rev. Robert Martin officiating. Interment will follow in the Wysox Cemetery with Towanda American Legion Post No. 42 according full military honors.
