James Michael "Jim" Nalisnick, 71, of North Towanda, PA passed away Tuesday evening, November 28, 2017, at Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA. Jim was born in Spangler, PA on February 3, 1946 the son of Nick and Anna Forberger Nalisnick. He was a graduate of Central Cambria High School class of 1964 and continued his education at St. Francis University, Loretta, PA graduating in 1968 where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry. On August 10, 1968, Jim married the former E. Arlene Myers at St Francis Xavier Catholic Church in Cresson, PA. Jim began his career as a chemist with E.I. DuPont in Seaford, DE and transferred to E.I DuPont in Towanda in February of 1979 where he remained until retirement in June of 2004. Jim was a member of SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Towanda, the Bridge Street Hill Rod and Gun Club, and was a former member and president of the St. Agnes School Board. Jim was an avid gardener, photographer and outdoorsman who enjoyed hunting and fishing. He also enjoyed helping his neighbors with snowplowing and mowing grass. 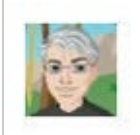
