



## James William Seipler

April 28, 1941 - May 7, 2019

James William “Jim” Seipler, 78 of 606 Ridge Road, Rome, PA, Orwell Township passed away peacefully Tuesday evening, May 7, 2019 at his home following declining health. Jim was born in Sayre, PA on April 28, 1941, the son of Floyd A. Seipler and Doris Birdsall Seipler. He grew up in Powell, PA and was a graduate of Towanda High School. Following high school, Jim enlisted in the U.S. Army where he served from June 19, 1959 to May 25, 1962. Following completion of his military service, Jim became employed as a teller by the Citizens & Northern Bank in Towanda in 1962, and in time advanced to become branch manager for both Towanda and Wysox locations. On June 24, 1964, Jim married the former Jane L. Robinson. In following years, Jim replaced Bill Miller as cashier and controller of the Citizens & Northern Bank in Towanda and subsequently served as chief finance officer. While working at the bank, Jim continued his education in business and computer science at Elmira College, attended Bloomsburg University for three years and was a graduate of the University of Wisconsin where he was certified in business, banking and finance. Jim was responsible for implementing the use of computer technology in the bank and was instrumental in the future growth, structure and success of Citizens & Northern. Jim retired from Citizens and Northern as Executive Vice President in 2002. During his retirement he also provided private tax preparation service for area families and businesses.

Jim was a past president and served as treasurer of the H.O.P.S. Ambulance

Association for 41 years and was very dedicated to organizing and facilitating the associations chicken bar-be-ques over the years. He was a founder and treasurer of the United Way Program in Towanda, served a board member of the Bradford County Big Brothers & Big Sisters Program, served as treasurer for the Towanda Beagle Club, was a past president and treasurer of the South Mountain Hunting Club and was a past president of the Pennsylvania Bankers Association. He was a member of the Red Run Rod & Gun Club. Jim loved spending time with his family, the outdoors, hunting, fishing, reading history, and raising and training beagles. Jim's family includes his wife of nearly 55 years, Jane L. Seipler, sons, Timmothy James Seipler Sr. (Nettie Zurn) of North Orwell, Todd William Seipler and wife Lori of Rome, grandchildren, Timothy James Seipler Jr. of North Carolina, Brandon Williams of Towanda, Tricia Hackel and husband Tom of Friendsville, great grandchildren, Jayce and Alyssa Hackel, brother, Floyd A. Seipler and wife Linda of Franklindale, sister, Doris Lee Swingle and husband Chuck of Towanda Township, aunt and uncle, Marge and Allen Seymour of Wysox Township, brothers-in-law, Donald Robinson of Rome, James Robinson of Rome Township, several nieces, nephew and cousins. In addition to his parents, Jim was predeceased by a nephew, Brian Seipler, his father-in-law, Donald E. Robinson and mother-in-law, Ellen Elizabeth Ayers Robinson.
