



Jerome Joseph Gorski

November 3, 1944 - February 27, 2016

Jerome Joseph Gorski, 71, highly regarded resident and educator of Sayre, PA passed away Saturday, February 27, 2016 at Troy Community Hospital, Troy, PA. Jerome was born in Waverly, NY on November 3, 1944 the son of Edward J. Gorski and Helen Ginalski Gorski. As a youth, Jerome lived in South Waverly moving to Sayre with his family at age 11. He was a graduate of Sayre High School and during his high school years played football with the undefeated Sayre Redskins Football Team. Jerome continued his education at Mansfield University where he received his Bachelor's degree in education and his Master's degree in guidance counseling from Penn State University. Mr. Gorski began his career in education first as a teacher and the remaining of his 47 total years with the Sayre Area School District as a guidance counselor retiring in 2014. Mr. Gorski was instrumental in the formation of the Sayre Soccer Program and served as a sports volunteer for many years. Surviving are his sons, Jason J. Gorski, wife Kendra and their children, Ella, Leo and Avery all of Sacramento, CA, Justin J. Gorski and his son, Preston of Owego, NY, Jared J. Gorski of Portland, OR, brother and sister-in-law, Donald E. and Jean Gorski of Sayre, niece, Deborah Gorski-Carl, and nephews, Steven and Gregory Gorski.

The family will receive friends Wednesday from 5 to 8 p.m. at the Alteri-Bowen Funeral Home 314 Desmond St. Sayre, PA. A mass of Christian burial will be held Thursday, March 3, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. at the Church of the Epiphany, South Elmer Ave. Sayre. Interment will be at a later date in St. James
