



## Jerry R. Chandler

Jerry R. Chandler, 87, of Sayre, PA passed away Tuesday, February 17, 2026, following declining health. Jerry was born in Sayre on May 29, 1938, the son of the late Ralph Chandler and Florence (Ritz) Chandler. Jerry served with the U. S. Air Force and U.S. Navy Reserves and following completion of his military service he worked with his father's contracting business.

He later operated his service station on North Main St. in Athens for a number of years before beginning his career as an iron worker. Jerry worked on numerous steel construction projects including Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, Thatcher Glass, Horseheads, NY, Corning Glass, Corning, NY and on bridge construction. During his retirement years, Jerry drove motor coach and worked in the pits for Geoff Bodine Motor Sports which he loved. In earlier years, he raced at Chemung Speedrome, Chemung, NY. Jerry was a member of the Church of the Redeemer in Sayre, was active with the Sayre Fire Department, life member of Sayre and Towanda Elks Lodges, and held membership with the Sky Diving Club. Jerry enjoyed the outdoors and was an avid hunter and fisherman.

Jerry is survived by a niece, Denise Macafee and husband Wayne of Athens, his companion of 54 years, Debra Titus of South Waverly, a cousin, Joe Chandler of Chemung and many special friends. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his sister, Jean Ann Babcock on November 25, 2020.
