Joanne Chapman Bidlack, 48, of Ulster, PA fought a courageous battle with cancer for the past seven years. On April 22, 2012 her battle ended but her life was full. Joanne was born in Johnson City, NY on September 11, 1963 the daughter of Earl and Lucille Johnson Chapman. Before settling in Ulster, Joanne lived with her family in Florida and Johnson City, NY. Joanne graduated from SRU High School in 1981 and Elmira Business Institute in 1983. She immediately began her career with the law firm of Davis, Murphy and Niemic followed by eleven years with Penelec in Towanda. She subsequently concentrated on managing the administrative needs for Bidlack & Sons and raising her sons. Joanne married Duane Bidlack on May 12, 1989 and they had three sons, Chase Austin (deceased), Jarrett Bruce and Reed Charles. Joanne's boys were her reason for living.
