John Charles George, 66, of Rome, Pa., Orwell Township, passed away Friday morning, Dec. 12, 2014 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, Pa.

John was born in Mountville, Pa. on Aug. 9, 1948, the son of Charles G. George and Helen Kissling George. He was a graduate of Hempfield High School, Mountville, Pa. with the class of 1966 and Delaware Valley College in 1970 where he received his degree in Agronomy. On Aug. 15, 1970 he married Donna Seibert in Columbia, Pa. During his college years, John served as a trainee with the Soil Conservation Service. Following completion of his college education John went to work for the Natural Resource Conservation Service (formerly the Soil Conservation Service) and remained there for 41 years until his retirement in 2008 as District Conservationist. He is survived by his wife, Donna; sons, Jason C. George and Christopher D. George both of Rome; brother, James S. George of Pennsylvania; as well as several nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Jacques George.
