Dr. John Finley Haines III., DDS, 73, of Warren Center, PA formerly of Monroeton, PA passed away Thursday, September 12, 2024, at Binghamton General Hospital, Binghamton, NY.

John was born in Towanda, PA on April 16, 1951, the son of the late John Finley Haines II, and Phyllis (Munkittrick) Haines. He grew up in Monroeton, attending elementary school there, and was a graduate of Towanda High School where he was an accomplished clarinet instrumentalist with the marching and concert bands. In early years, John was active in Boy Scouts and achieved the distinguished honor of Eagle Scout. He continued his education at Temple University in Philadelphia graduating in 1973 and matriculated to the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine, Pittsburgh, PA graduating in 1977. While continuing his education, John worked in Acme Supermarket Stores in Towanda, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh. John began his dental career with the office of Dr. George Lasco and later began his own dental practice in Towanda Borough initially located on Lombard Street and subsequently on York Avenue where he remained for 40 years until retirement due to health concerns.

Dr. Haines keen intellect provided opportunities to pursue vast interests especially in local history, and as a collector of memorabilia. He greatly enjoyed building their dream home on Lake O'Meadows and the peace and community there, the outdoors, spending time on the water, fishing, and attending their granddaughters' sports and dancing events.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus 4th degree.
