Joseph E. "Joe" Mihalek Jr., 69, of Orwell Township, PA passed away Wednesday morning, May 23, 2018 at the Athens Health Care Center, Athens, PA.

Joe was born in Philadelphia, PA on June 28, 1948 the son of Joseph E. Mihalek Sr. and Stella T. Dilkus Mihalek. He was a graduate of Neshaminy High School now known as Feasterville High School with the Class of 1966. Joe later served with the U.S. Army from April 29, 1968 to April 28, 1971 during the Vietnam War. Joe owned and operated the Wysox Exxon station for 25 years and for several years served as a school bus driver for the Northeast Bradford School District. Joe was a Deputy Game Protector for the Pennsylvania Game Commission for 30 years. He enjoyed the outdoors, hunting and fishing.
