Kate Skerpon, 92, of Sayre, passed away Sunday, May 17, 2015 at her home. Born January 11, 1923 in Sayre, she was the daughter of the late Umberto and Maria Quattrini Pace.

Kate was a graduate of the Sayre Area High School class of 1940.

In early years she first worked at the Newberry's store in downtown Sayre and then at the Eclipse in Elmira during World War II. Following employment at the Blue Swan in Sayre, she went to work at Label Processing System (later named Paxar) starting in 1970 until her retirement in 1984 at the age of 62.

On April 24, 1948, she married John Skerpon at the Church of the Epiphany in Sayre with Father John Gough presiding. She was a member of the Church of the Epiphany and the Sons of Italy.

Kate enjoyed walking, knitting and spending time with her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren and friends. "Grandma's toasted cheese" for Fridays at lunch was always a special time. She also enjoyed watching her grandchildren running; playing lacrosse, football, baseball, soccer, and basketball; and playing musical instruments. Kate had a special place in her

heart for family and friends and was known for sending cards on all occasions.
