Kenneth Stanley "Ken" Ginalski, 79, of Sayre, PA passed away Thursday, February 16, 2023, following declining health. Kenneth was born in Sayre on October 14, 1943, the son of the late Stanley J. Ginalski Jr. and Anna I. (Kenish) Ginalski. He was a graduate of Sayre High School with the class of 1961 and in October of 1961 Kenneth began serving with the U.S. Navy until the completion of his Naval service in October of 1964. With the desire to fulfill his life ambition, Ken began his great adventure to sail around the world in his sailboat. Following many memorable months at sea and visiting and experiencing numerous countries during this period in life, he returned home to Sayre with the goal of furthering his education.

Ken subsequently attended Broome Community College in Binghamton, NY and upon graduation received his degree in computer programming. In 1974, Ken moved to Alaska where he resided in numerous locations while working as a millwright on the Alyeska Pipeline. He returned home to Sayre in 2000 to begin enjoying his retirement years. Ken was a member of Skiff-Bower VFW Post in Sayre and the Sayre Elks Lodge. He enjoyed working extensively on his home, caring for his fish, and spending time socializing with family and many friends in both the valley area and Alaska. Ken will be remembered by many for his congenial personality, kindness, and generosity.

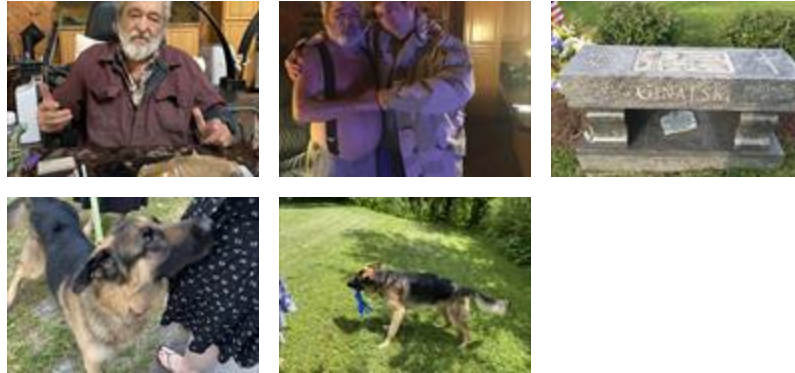
