Carol then began her Home Economics teaching career in the New Albany High School which later became part of the Wyalusing School District. She transitioned to teaching Elementary Special Education in 1964, retiring in 1984.

Carol was an active member of the New Albany Parish Council for many years and most recently the New Albany Methodist Church. Carol enjoyed sewing and quilting.
