Lawrence "Larry" Fulmer, 76, of Towanda, PA unexpectedly passed away December 23, 2020 surrounded by his loving family at the Towanda Memorial Hospital.

Larry was born on November 4, 1944 in Williamsport, PA to Leo and Verna (Featherbay) Fulmer. He served in the U.S Army in Korea during the Vietnam War. After serving he met his beloved wife Vickie J. (Waltz) Fulmer. On June 8, 1968 they married and resided in Towanda, Pa where they raised two sons, Brett and Bradley Fulmer.

Larry was a respected and loved local businessman.
