Lawrence L. "Larry" Rubert formerly of Sayre, PA passed away Thursday, November 2, 2023, at the Fairview Rehabilitation Center in Hudson, NH. Lawrence was born in Athens, PA on November 7, 1927, the son of Lawrence T. Rubert and Ruth Nichols Rubert. "Larry" grew up in the Monroeton and Towanda, PA areas and was a graduate of Towanda High School. On October 29, 1949, he married the former Ann Bubniak of Sayre at the Ascension of Our Lord Ukrainian Catholic Church in Sayre. Larry was employed by GTE Sylvania in Towanda for 35 years until his retirement.

Larry and Ann were dedicated members of the Epiphany Parish in Sayre and actively volunteered in the Epiphany Bingo program for over 28 years. Larry was a member of the Waverly Moose and Roma Madre Lodge No. 1342 Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in Sayre where Larry also participated in the Bingo programs. Larry enjoyed playing golf and shuffleboard and was a fan of the New York Yankees and New York Giants.
