Leila May Madigan Kilmer, 95, of Towanda, Asylum Township, PA passed away Sunday, April 20, 2025, at the Sayre Health Care Center, Athens Township, PA.

Leila was born in Towanda on May 1, 1929, the daughter of Mylen H. Madigan and Fanny Elmira Dyer Madigan. She was a graduate of Towanda High School with the class of 1947 and continued her education at Penn State University, University Park, where she received her Bachelor of Science degree in Home Economics Education upon graduation in 1951. Leila served as a teacher of Home Economics at Wyalusing High School for several years and later chose to be at home to raise her family. Leila was a member of the French Asylum United Methodist Church and the United Methodist Women's Group, Wysox Fire Company Auxiliary, Penn State Alumni Association, the PenNy Promenaders and several additional square dance organizations.
