Leo F. "Sam" Schultz Sr., 76, of Towanda, PA passed away early Sunday morning, June 2, 2013 at the Geisinger Medical Center in Danville, PA.

Leo was born July 28, 1936 in Towanda, PA the son of Francis and Grace Wilson Schultz.

He was a graduate of Towanda High School Class of 1955 and later served in the U.S. Navy for three years. On June 22, 1963 Leo married the former Virginia Catherine Smith at the First United Methodist Church in Towanda. In early years, Leo was employed by Wysox Sand and Gravel and by the former ESSO service station on Main Street in Towanda. He was later employed by GTE Sylvania in Towanda for over 30 years until his retirement. Leo enjoyed sports events especially attending Towanda High School football and girls volley ball games. In early years he coached Towanda Little League Baseball.

Leo and Virginia enjoyed traveling extensively throughout the United States. The couple spent their winter months in Haines City, Florida for a number of years and looked forward to special trips to Disney World. He was preceded in death by his wife of 46 years on November 11, 2009. Leo formerly served as a Towanda Borough Councilman and was past president and captain of drivers for the Towanda Ambulance Association for over 30 years. He was a member of Union Lodge No. 108 F. & A.M. Towanda, the Ancient Accepted Scottish

Rite Bodies Valley of Towanda and Williamsport, Towanda Elks Lodge No. 2191, Towanda Gun Club and was a social member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42.
