Levi W. Roof, 90, of 40 Bonin Road, Rome, PA, Orwell Twp., passed away peacefully Tuesday morning, March 20, 2012 at his home. Born in Herrick Township, PA on March 22, 1921 he was the son of Roy and Mabel Wells Roof. Levi was a graduate of Camptown High School class of 1941 and later served in the Army Air Force during World War II. On May 6, 1949 he married Frances Gorham in Sayre, PA. In early years, Levi was employed by C.C. Allis & Sons in Herrickville, GTE Sylvania in Towanda, Towanda High School and was a self employed general contractor. He was later employed as Building and Grounds Director for Northeast Bradford High School from 1963 until his retirement. He was a member of the Orwell Bible Church, Bradford County Historical Society, Roman Lodge No. 418 F. & A.M. and the American Legion. He served as a 4H leader and on the 4H Leaders Advisory Council in Bradford County for many years. Levi enjoyed carpentry projects and working with stained glass.
