Linda T. Fisher 87, passed away peacefully at her home in Towanda Saturday evening April 6, 2019, while watching TV with her spouse nearby. She had often expressed her desire to make her transition in the comfort of the home where she had lived most of her life and both of her parents had made their transitions. That wish was fulfilled as well as the prayers of her family that the event be acknowledged as a spiritual gift for the love she shared with all of her families.

Linda was the daughter of Loyd Moreland and Elizabeth Reece Trimmer and was born in Towanda on March 20, 1932.

Linda attended the local schools and graduated from Towanda H.S. in the class of 1950. She enrolled in Drexel University in Philadelphia where she graduated in 1954 with a BS degree in Home Economics. When her last child entered school she decided to expand her love for reading by becoming a school librarian and pursued a bachelor degree in Library Science at Mansfield University and a Master's degree from Marywood University. Linda then served as Librarian at Sayre High School for 27 years, retiring in 1997. She enjoyed assisting and teaching the students the fundamentals of library searches necessary to research their required subjects and term papers. She was Class Advisor several times and chaperoned their class trips providing her with many happy memories and experiences.

She married Arthur P. Fisher on January 2, 1954 in Towanda. Their children are: Arthur Reece Fisher of Steamboat Springs, CO; Christian Eves Fisher of Wysox; Allison Moreland Fisher of Joshua Tree, CA; and Margaret Trimmer (Jessie) Quirante of Joshua Tree, CA. Linda's family includes the children and their descendants of her late brother Loyd Reece Trimmer and Jane Davis Cranmer Doherty: Elizabeth Trimmer McKinley; Davis James Trimmer; Julia Trimmer (Keith) Glidewell; and Loyd Moreland (Susan) Trimmer, all residing in North Carolina. Linda lived her life to the fullest. She was possessed of great energy, vitality and endurance. A gourmet cook, she sewed and knitted beautiful clothes for her family. Linda enjoyed being with her family at home or camping beside 7th Lake in the Adirondack Mountains, hiking, canoeing, sailing, swimming and preparing the meals for the hungry family and guests. She became a friend of her children's friends and a second mother to many of them. They will always remember her by the loving concern she shared with them.
