



Lloyd William "Bill" Bailey

November 22, 1932 - February 10, 2019

Lloyd William "Bill" Bailey, 86, of Ulster, PA passed away Sunday morning, February 10, 2019 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA after many months of loving care provided by his children. "Bill", as he was known by his family and friends, was born in Sayre on November 22, 1932 the son of Newton W. Bailey and Pearl Gustin Bailey. He was a graduate of Towanda High School and was a veteran of the Korean War having served with the U.S. Army. Bill was employed by the Ingersoll-Rand in Athens for 42 years until retirement. He was a member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42, Skiff-Bower VFW Post No. 1536, Sayre, was a life member of the Towanda Gun Club and was a social member of Roma Madre Lodge No 1342 Order Sons and Daughters of Italy, Sayre. Bill enjoyed most working on his tractors - considered an expert mechanic by many, carpentry, woodworking, hunting, fishing, and camping throughout the summers. He shared his knowledge, tools, and equipment willingly whenever asked.

He is survived by his wife, Betty J. Bailey, as well as his children, Susan B. Raver of Hanover, PA, Lloyd J. Bailey and fiancé Kelly Robinson of Ulster, Brian Bailey and wife Helen of Luthers Mills, Patricia Carr and husband Jack of Stevensville, many loving grandchildren and great grandchildren, brother Russell B.
