He loved the outdoors, especially hunting, fishing, and golfing. Lately, whenever he had spare time, he would head to the golf course. Logan was an avid reader and had a huge collection of philosophy, history, finance, and personal development books. A collection of Logan's books will be donated to the Bradford County Library. Logan prided himself on the knowledge that he obtained from years of studying the stock market. He was a remarkable trader and was always interested in teaching others about trading.

Above all, Logan loved Jesus Christ and his Family. Through his struggles and triumphs, Logan always held tight to his strong faith. His small, worn Bible has traveled to many states and now is in the hands of his sister. He attended "Sunday Church" in his Grandmother Abbott's living room via television. This will forever be a special memory.

Putting others before himself came naturally. Like his friend, JD, said "He'd give you the shirt off his back." He was always present to cheer on his sister and celebrate her achievements. As Madison put it, "He was the best big brother, and I loved him with my whole heart." He spent each Christmas buying for children in need and delivering gifts right up to Christmas Eve. He gave of himself in so many ways, from the simplest of packing extra sandwiches for a co-worker that might be hungry, to stopping his car and taking the shovel from an elderly man to finish digging a hole.

He will be deeply missed by all that loved him, and he has taught us to be observant of the small details of kindness & giving.
