Lori Moore Wells, 61 of Athens, Pennsylvania passed away on May 9, 2024, after a sudden diagnosis of cancer. Lori was born in Towanda, Pennsylvania on June 10, 1962, the daughter of Gayle and Ann Moore. She was a lifelong resident of Bradford County. Her pride and joy were her children, Eric Wells, and Jennifer Wells-Whittaker. Lori dedicated her life to being a mom and never hesitated to drop everything she was doing to put her children first. She traveled the state and country watching baseball, football, softball, and volleyball games; provided unwavering support for Eric as he battled his liver disease and liver transplant and never hesitated to jump in and help Jennifer move to a new state when asked. In 2018, she was elated to hear the news she would be having twin grandsons, Austin and Jaxon Wells, whom she loved spending time with. Lori started working for the Athens Area School District in 1999 and served an honorable 25 years with the district, first as the Attendance Secretary and later as administrative support to the principal. While with the district, Lori enjoyed working at football, basketball, and volleyball games; Lori tackled graduation head on along with any the other projects thrown her way. She never hesitated to work late or take work home; she loved her job and was committed to helping students, faculty, and staff. Lori was predeceased by her parents. She is survived by her children, Eric (Wendy) Wells, of Exeter, New Hampshire, Jennifer (Robert) Whittaker of Newnan, Georgia, her grandchildren, Austin Wells, Jaxon Wells, and step grandchild, Makinzy Whittaker. She is also survived by her siblings, Kyle (Lori)

Moore, Curtis (Connie) Moore, and Tammy (John) Felondis. Her memory will forever live on through her family and friends.
