M. Glenn Lewis, 67, of Liberty Corners, PA passed away Wednesday, December 27, 2017, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Glenn was born in Buckhannon, West Virginia on July 4, 1950, the son of Gordon J. Thomas and Nellie Irene Lewis Thomas. Glenn began his working career as a roofing and painting contractor and later served in installation and repair for emergency services. He was employed by Hinkle & McCoy for 25 years and subsequently by High Steel Construction until his retirement in 2007. Glenn worked on construction projects locally at Proctor & Gamble in Mehoopany, PA, Memorial Hospital in Towanda, PA and the Bradford Town Center in Wysox, PA as well as numerous additional developments. Glenn was a well-known pipefitter and millwright. He enjoyed the outdoors, hunting, fishing riding motorcycle, boating and wood working. He possessed artistic talents especially in painting and drawing. Surviving are his life companion of 33 years, Dee A. Reeves of Liberty Corners, mother, Nellie I. Thomas of Buckhannon, WV, sisters, Linda Lou Dean of Outerbanks, NC, Belinda Ellen Timmins (Kevin J. Gray) of Mountville, PA as well as several aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins. He was predeceased by his father, Gordon J. Thomas on April 8, 2016 and sister, Virginia Ann Spangler in May of 2003. A memorial service will be held at a later date. 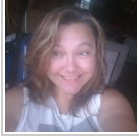


“ Loving Memories (Your Gentle Face)
