February 27, 1938 - February 13, 2016

Madeline Marie Demangone Repine, 77, died on Saturday, Feb. 13, 2016, at the Guthrie Towanda Memorial Hospital in Towanda. Madeline's health had steadily declined during the past year.

Madeline was predeceased by her parents, Mary and John Demangone in 1980 and by her supportive and caring ex-husband, Charles Repine, who died in July 2013.

She is survived by her brother John, and sister-in-law Mary Alice Demangone. Also surviving is her Aunt Fern Demangone from Mt. Pleasant, Pa. and the following nieces and nephews: John and Marcy Demangone, Reading, Pa.; Concetta and Robert Oglesby, Greenville, N.C.; Michael and Karen Demangone, Page, Ariz.; Julie and John Friedrich, Elmira Heights, N.Y.; and Anthony and Amanda Briggs Demangone, Arlington, Va. Plus several great nieces and great nephews and many cousins in the Pittsburgh area.

Madeline was born on Feb. 27, 1938, in Latrobe, Pa.. She graduated from Latrobe High School. Madeline battled mental illness during most of her 77 years but was able to experience many wonderful times. The highlight of her life was her marriage to Charles Repine for over 25 years. They were married in Ronan, Mont. in 1963 and eventually moved back to the Pittsburgh area. During their married life Madeline and Chuck enjoyed traveling up and down the east coast and it was common for them to include their beloved nieces and nephews. In May 1992 Madeline moved to Towanda to be near her brother John and sister-in-law Mary Alice.

Madeline was a member of SS. Peter & Paul's Parish where she faithfully attended the 5 p.m. Saturday mass and where she found many special friends.

A special recognition and thanks should be made to Gary and Julie Schmeck who cared for Madeline for several years in their personal care home and to the staff at the Wyalusing Personal Care Home and the Bradford County Manor who also ministered to Madeline in her latter years.

The family will receive friends at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home, 217 York Ave., Towanda, on Friday, Feb. 19.
