Margaret Delia Webster Allen, 77, of Evergreen, PA. passed away Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at the Bradford County Manor in West Burlington Township, PA after a lengthy battle with Alzheimer's Disease.

Margaret was born July 13, 1941 at Mills Hospital in Towanda, PA the daughter of Laura Cole Webster and Stephen Webster. She was raised on her grandfather's farm in North Towanda along with her sister, Betty Lou, and loved to tell the story of her childhood there.

Margaret graduated from Towanda High School in 1959. She received her certification as an x-ray technician from The Paul Smith Rehabilitation Center in Saranac Lake, NY and completed her training in x-ray technology at Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital in Binghamton, NY. There she met and married John Lomma on November 5, 1960. She later married Duane Allen on October 31, 1964 at the North Towanda Methodist Church. They were married for 45 years before his passing on February 23, 2009. Margaret was employed at the Towanda Memorial Hospital for 10 years and then went to work at E.I. DuPont in Towanda for over 35 years before her retirement. She was hired at DuPont to work on the coaters and eventually became the plant medical assistant.

Margaret served as a volunteer for the American Red Cross Blood Bank at DuPont for over 35 years and was honored for the number of gallons of blood she was able to collect for donations, as well as donating 7 gallons herself.

Margaret served as Mrs. Claus for the DuPont Children's Christmas Party

which she loved doing. She was a member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42 Ladies Auxiliary and donated many hours serving meals at the post. Margaret was an avid reader and loved to travel. She enjoyed many summer vacation trips to Canada, loved attending NASCAR races with Duane in their camper, saw the pony's run on Chincoteague Island, been to St. Lucia in the Caribbean on a cruise and traveled to Ireland with her sister, Betty Lou and stepmother, Elsie Webster. Margaret enjoyed music and had taken many bus trips to New York City to see shows on Broadway with her friend Margo Roof. Margaret was preceded in death by her beloved grandfather, Ray Cole (Dee Dee) and wife Irene Cole (Nannie), her mother, Laura Cole Benjamin, father, Stephen Webster, stepfather, Clinton Benjamin, husbands, John Lomma and Duane Allen, her sister, Betty Lou Webster Lewis and brother-in-law, Jack Lewis.
