Margaret E. "Peg" Miller, 83, of 131 Colonial Drive, Towanda, PA passed away Tuesday, February 26, 2019, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Miller and Mary Finlan Miller, Peg graduated from St. Agnes High School in Towanda and worked at Ingersoll-Rand in Athens, PA for more than 30 years until retirement.
