Marie Ann Costello House, 87, of Towanda, Asylum Township, PA passed away peacefully Monday afternoon, April 4, 2022, at her home. Marie was born November 19, 1934, in Wellsville, NY the daughter of Fred A. Costello and Anna Regan Costello. She was a graduate of Wellsville High School with the Class of 1952 and continued her education at Saint James Mercy Hospital School of Nursing graduating in June of 1955. On April 14, 1956, Marie married Thomas P. House in Wellsville, NY.

Marie was employed as a registered nurse and later as a pharmacy technician with Memorial Hospital in Towanda from June of 1979 until her retirement on January 8, 1999.
