Marion A. Lent, 99, of 603 William St. Towanda, formerly of Lake Wesauking, Wysox Township, PA passed away Sunday evening, August 7, 2016 at Guthrie Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA.

Marion was born in Syracuse, NY on May 27, 1917 the daughter of the late Ralph M. Brown Sr. and Sara Jones Brown. She was a graduate of Central High School in Syracuse, NY and after raising her family she attended Mansfield University. Marion received her Master's Degree in Education from Penn State University. Mrs. Lent taught Second and Fourth Grades at the elementary schools of Towanda First Ward, Mulberry Street, Towanda Township and Monroe-Franklin for a combined total of 15 years until her retirement in 1979. Marion became a member of the Wysox Presbyterian Church in 1953 where she served as an elder and deacon and was a member of the Wysox Sewing Society and Wysox Prayer Circle.

She also held membership with the Wysox Volunteer Fire Company Auxiliary, Sheshequin Book Club, the national and state education associations as well as the Bradford-Sullivan Education Association. Mrs. Lent served as a tutor for the Laubach Literacy Program for a number of years.
