Marjorie J. "Marge" Bailey Douglas, 87, of East Amherst, NY formerly of Towanda, PA passed away Saturday morning, March 10, 2018 at Millard Fillmore Suburban Hospital in Williamsville, NY.

Marjorie was born October 21, 1930 in Towanda, PA the daughter of Aaron and Ethel Stone Bailey. She was a graduate of Towanda High School Class of 1949 and in early years was employed by the Commonwealth Telephone Company in Towanda. On April 18, 1953, Marjorie married Francis P. 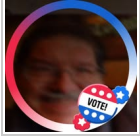
