Mark A. McLaud, 55, of Towanda, PA passed away Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at Guthrie Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA. Mark was born in Sayre, PA on August 17, 1965, a son of Robert G. McLaud Sr. and Bethel Sands McLaud. He was a graduate of Towanda Area High School with the Class of 1983 and Mansfield University with the Class of 1987. On May 11, 1996, Mark married Barbara E. He was later employed by Williams Oil Company in Towanda and Williams Companies of Sayre. 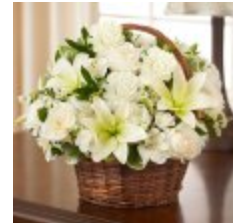
