Marlene A. Northrup was born in Sayre, PA on April 3, 1935, the daughter of Mercur and Rheta Sollick Johnson. She grew up in Sayre and was a 1953 graduate of Sayre High School. Generous and talented as well as highly opinionated, Marlene employed the full weight of her gifts in raising eight children and being a devoted grandmother, great-grandmother, and friend. As a young woman, Marlene worked at the Blue Swan Mills and later drove school buses for the Waverly School District while raising her growing family.
