Mary Louise "Mary Lou" Shearer-Brennan, 66 formerly of Towanda passed away February 18, 2025, at her residence in Beaver Lake, Lycoming County, PA. She was born in Towanda, Pennsylvania on March 10, 1958, the daughter of the late Nelson and Anita "Bettie" O'Keefe Shearer.

Mary Lou married Terence Brennan at Saints Peter and Paul Church in Towanda on May 23, 1987; Terry survives her. After their marriage Mary Lou and Terry lived in Sayre, PA until Terry was transferred to Williamsport and they relocated there at that time.

Mary Lou attended St. Agnes Elementary school and graduated from Towanda area High School with the class of 1976. After graduation she attended Mansfield University.
