Michael J. Scheithauer, 67, of 1733 Saco Road, Ulster, PA passed away Thursday evening, January 17, 2019 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Michael was born in Towanda, PA on January 17, 1952, the son of William Scheithauer Sr. and Grace Chubbuck Scheithauer. Michael was a 1969 graduate of Towanda High School and a 1971 graduate of the Pennsylvania School of Technology in Williamsport, PA. Michael also served in the U.S. Army Reserves for many years. Following graduation from Penn Tech, Michael became employed by GTE Sylvania and retired from Osram Sylvania in Towanda in 2010. Michael was a member of the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation and the National Wild Turkey Federation. He loved the outdoors, taking hunting trips out west, gardening, and shooting darts. In early years, Michael flew remote control airplanes with his friend Dave Birchard. Surviving are his wife, Wenda L.
