Michelle M. (Marcoccia) Netherton, 57, of Towanda, returned to the loving arms of her savior on Monday at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre. She was born on July 18, 1968, in Towanda to the late Louis and Dianne (Gunderman) Marcoccia.

Growing up, Michelle was a member of the Towanda Top Hats color guard. She spoke often of the dedication and commitment it took for them to make it to the world competition in Holland in 1984 and did her best to instill that work ethic in her sons.

After graduating from Towanda High School in 1986, Michelle moved to Lawton, OK briefly with her then-husband, Kevin Sutton, and newborn Eric, before returning home. She worked at the Daily Review for the next 23+ years. In 2003, Michelle welcomed her second child, Cameron, who filled her life with love. Towards the end of her time with the Daily Review, she met and married the love of her life, Johnny Netherton, on March 15, 2007.

After leaving the Daily Review, Michelle joined her brother Mark and beloved sister-in-law Lois at their car dealerships in Towanda and Sayre. Some of her favorite times were traveling with Mark and Lois, whether that be to Seneca Lake for the weekend or longer trips to Atlantic City and Las Vegas.

From a young age, traveling was always an adventure for Michelle. In addition to Holland in high school, she also visited Canada, Mexico, several cities in the United States, and multiple cruises to Alaska and the Caribbean. In the last 2 years, Michelle was determined to make as many memories as

possible, taking her granddaughters, Sara and Catherine, to Disney and Universal Studios in Orlando, as well as other weekend trips.

Michelle was preceded in death by her parents Louis and Dianne Marcoccia and her sister-in-law Lois Marcoccia. She is survived by her husband Johnny Netherton, of Towanda, her son and daughter-in-law, Eric and Alicia Sutton, of Camptown, and son Cameron Marcoccia, of Cumming, GA, and stepdaughter Amanda (Mickey) Hurlburt, of Owego.
