



Nancy A. Lindstrom

August 6, 1943 - August 15, 2014

Nancy A. Lindstrom, 71, of North Towanda, PA passed away in the early morning hours of Friday, August 15, 2014 at Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA.

Nancy was born in Short Pump, VA on August 6, 1943, the daughter of Carey and Nellie Nuckols Attkisson. She was a 1961 graduate of Patrick Henry High School in Rockville, VA and she continued her education at several local colleges in Pennsylvania.

Nancy and her husband Tom owned the Towanda Tree Farm. They created the business from the ground up on an abandoned dairy farm in North Towanda and then expanded their wholesale business over the years to include additional farms in Smithfield Township and Dundee, NY. Visiting the Farm in North Towanda during the holidays to cut a tree out of the field became a local tradition for many families in the region.

She was a member of the Pennsylvania Christmas Tree Association and the Pennsylvania Nurserymen's Association.

Nancy was an active member of the Towanda Rotary Club and for many years served as Chairwoman of the Youth Exchange Program. Over the years, she and Tom personally hosted 15 students in their home. Nancy was named a

Paul Harris Fellow by the Rotary Foundation for her work with the Youth Exchange Program.

She also served as a board member and treasurer for the Towanda Public Library and was instrumental in the acquisition and renovation of the new Library Annex.

She was an active and supportive “Swim Mom” and “Band Mom” while her daughters participated in the Aqua Ducks Swim Club and the Towanda High School swim team and marching band, serving as announcer for swim meets and as a chaperone for many activities.

Nancy worked for Farm Credit in North Towanda for ten years and previously served as a bookkeeper for North Towanda Township. She also taught computer courses for Lackawanna College in Towanda.

Nancy leaves her love and influence throughout her community and the world.

Surviving are her daughters, Janette Lindstrom Fein and husband James of Sagamore Beach, MA; Christine Lindstrom and Andrew MacDonald of Boston, MA; Adrienne Lindstrom and husband Matthew Graham of Simsbury, CT; her beloved grandchildren, Christopher Fein and Marit MacDonald; brother, Ken Attkisson and wife Nanette of Rockville, VA; sister, Diane Hartzog and husband Robert of High Point, NC; several nieces and nephews including Bethany Fiers McCord of Rotunda West, FL, and Suzanne Fiers Martin of Las Vegas, NV.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Thomas C. Lindstrom on April 16, 2005 and sister-in-law, Kay Lindstrom Fiers on June 3, 2006.

On Thursday, August 21, 2014 from 5 to 7 p.m. the family will receive friends at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home, 217 York Ave., Towanda, PA. A private interment will be held at the Bradford County Memorial Park in Luthers Mills, PA.
