Nanette H. Good, 74, passed away unexpectedly yet peacefully on Tuesday, April 29th in her home at Mountain Lake.

She is survived by her husband of over 50 years, James Good; siblings William (Ruth) Huffman, Adele (Charles) Hix, Janet (Thomas) Nowak; brothers-in-law Foster Frank (Diana) Good, David (Sally) Good, and sister-in-law Elizabeth (Thomas) Lane. She is predeceased by a brother David Huffman.

Nanette is a graduate of Wyalusing Valley High School '68 and Mansfield State Teachers College with a Master's Degree in Education. She taught elementary school in Sullivan County and at Troy area schools.

Nanette and Jim co-ran Mountain Lake Electric and Mountain Lake Construction & Overhead Doors. Nanette was the former owner of Arey Building Supply.

Nanette was a lifelong member of St. John's Lutheran Church where she was the organist for over 50 years and a decades long member of church council.

Nanette was a founding board member of the Bradford County Regional Arts Council. She was a member of the Burlington / West Burlington Halloween

Parade Committee.

Nanette was a Girl Scout leader in Troy, PA. She was an active part of Boy Scout Troop 4049 in Troy as well.

She started the Kids in Safety Seats (KISS) program in Towanda in the early 1980s and was part of the Memorial Hospital Auxiliary. She was a past member of Towanda Jaycettes.

She enjoyed square dancing, skiing and traveling.

Family will be present at Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home on York Avenue in Towanda on Wednesday, May 7th from 1-3pm and 5-8pm. Funeral services will be Thursday, May 8th at 10am at St. John's Lutheran Church in Wilmot Township. Internment will follow at Mountain Lake Cemetery on Burlington Turnpike.
