Naomi Joyce Garrison Cole, 87, formerly of Waverly, NY passed away Thursday, November 30, 2023, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Naomi was born April 17, 1936, in Tioga Center, NY the youngest of 11 children to Walter Garrison and Carrie Shaffer Garrison. She was a graduate of Waverly High School with the class of 1953. On January 1, 1955, Naomi married Elwood Earl Cole. Naomi was employed by Marine Midland Bank in Waverly which later became HSBC Bank for many years.
