Neil E. Herrington, 92, formerly of Florida, Troy, and Sayre, PA passed away Tuesday evening, July 10, 2018 at Guthrie Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA. Neil was born New York City on February 3, 1926 the son of Steven Henry Herrington Sr. and Mary Wishrad Herrington. On his 17th birthday, Neil entered the U.S. Navy. He served on the “Destroyer” during World War II, and then went into the reserves only to be called back to duty during the Korean War. His naval service provided opportunity to travel the world via the Mediterranean, Pacific and Atlantic. In early years, Neil worked as a milkman and later owned and operated a vending machine company, served as an auctioneer and was the owner and broker of Cardinal Real Estate.
