



## Nicholas Nick Frost

June 14, 1923 - September 25, 2015

Nicholas “Nick” Frost, 92, of Sayre, PA passed into the presence of his Savior Friday, September 25, 2015 following a long period of declining health.

Nick was born June 14, 1923 in Afognak, AK the son of John Thomas Jenkins Frost and Susan

Sheratin Frost. Nick moved with his family to Kodiak, AK in his early teens and was a graduate of Kodiak High School in 1941. He subsequently served in the U.S. Army for three years during World War II. With the GI Bill, he was a graduate of San Francisco State College where he received his Business Administration and Accounting degree. In the summers he fished commercially for salmon in the waters around Kodiak Island. He was employed by the GMC Truck and Coach Company in Pontiac, Michigan for 4 years where he met and married the love of his life the former Margaret Sharp. Nick served as city clerk-treasurer and magistrate in Kodiak, AK for 5 years and later as comptroller for Kodiak Airways in Kodiak for 3 years. During those years he became involved as a charter member of the Berean Baptist Church. Nick served as a student instructor at Cedarville College for 2 years and as secretary-treasurer for Baptist Mid-Missions in Cleveland, Ohio for 20 years until his retirement. Nick was enrolled as an elder and original shareholder in the Koniag and Afognak native corporations as the result of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of 1971. In retirement, he has lived in Sequim, Washington, Zephyrhills, FL and Sayre. Nick was a member of the Independent Baptist Church in Towanda. Nick enjoyed reading.

His family includes his beloved wife of 62 years, Margaret "Peggy" Sharp Frost whom he married on July 11, 1953 in Royal Oak, Michigan, children, Lynnette Marie Frost Hauser and husband Pastor Donn Hauser of Towanda, Duane Thomas Frost and wife Renee' Moore Frost of Taylorville, NC, grandchildren, Scott Ryan Hauser and wife Rachel Ruth Ross Hauser of Towanda and Stacey Rose Hauser of Towanda, brothers, William Frost and wife Joan of Seattle, WA, Cyril "Bob" Frost and wife Judy of Austin, TX, Richard Frost and wife Glenda of Anchorage, AK, sister, Mary Koenig of Seattle, WA, as well as several nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to his parents he was predeceased by infant children, Nicolette Marie Frost and Nicholas Frost Jr., daughter, Jacquenette Marie Frost Abercrombie, brothers, Joseph Frost, Thomas Frost, sisters, Donna Reed and Kay Byerle.

A memorial service will be held Tuesday, September 29, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. at the Independent Baptist Church, Cherry St. Towanda, PA with Pastor Donn Hauser officiating.

Interment will be private in the Oak Hill Cemetery, Towanda, PA.
