July 29, 1961 - October 12, 2025

Pamela "Pam" Beers of Wysox Township, PA lost her courageous battle with cancer in the early hours on Sunday morning, October 12, 2025, at home. Pam Beers was born July 29, 1961, to the late William F. Weber Sr. and Florence Suhr Weber in Somerset Hospital, Somerville, New Jersey. Pam was one of 10 children, 7 boys and 3 girls, Pam being the youngest daughter. In May of 1969, her father wanted to retire in a rural area, even though Somerset County N.J. was a farming area at the time. The family moved to the Glen Road in Wysox Township to the former Russell and Jane Hilfiger farm. Pam went to first grade at the Wysox Elementary School. Mrs. Linda Blanchard was her first- grade teacher, and made a lasting impression on a little shy kid. The previous older teacher didn't show the kindness little kids need. Pam has said Mrs. Blanchard "changed my life". Thank you to Mrs. Blanchard! Pam also made a life-long friendship in third grade with Cythnia Beers (Aeppli). Pam also thought highly of Mr. Jack Fox and Mr. Mark Henery of Towanda High School. Pam is a 1980 Towanda High School graduate. Pam's best friend in high school was Mary Ann Calkins, she was maid of honor at Pam's wedding. One of the bus drivers was a young man named Eugene C. Beers, and on October 18, 1980 they were married by Pastor Larry Burke at the North Rome Wesleyan Church. They are the parents of Jenelle and Nathan Beers. Their lives have been enriched by their three granddaughters, Katelynn, Kamryn and Jexi that survive her. Pam is survived by her husband Eugene C. Beers, her siblings locally are Diane Elliott, Kenneth Weber

(Karen) and David Weber (Teri), her mother in-law Harriet (Beers) Roof, sister in-law Cynthnia Beers Aeppli and her husband Jeffery Aeppli. She has many nieces and nephews. She is predeceased by two older brothers, William F. Weber Jr. and George Weber.

Pam started working at age 16 at the Wysox A & W, she knew if she wanted something, she would have to work for it. She wanted to buy contact lenses and working at the A & W, she reached her goal, and has been working ever since. Pam worked at Montgomery Ward and Sears of Wysox. Then she worked at the P & A Burger Pit owned by Bob and Ruth Heath. Bob said if Pam was taking a break, she deserved it! Pam was a worker. She has been in the banking business for over 30 years. She has been at the First Citizens Community Bank in Towanda for over 20 years, becoming bank manager in July 2024. Although she was a quiet person and very private, she cherished her family and friends. Her husband Gene worked construction, and having a nice home was their goal. Gene built the home that they lived in for the past 40 years. Pam took pride of their home, inside and outside. She enjoyed the many flower beds around her beautiful home. She left her family with many cherished memories. In the last year and a half, Pam had taken up the game of golf. She started playing with her youngest brother Dave. That gave them a brother-sister bond, that Dave will always cherish. Pam with her sister and two brothers had monthly get togethers at her house. They shared food, laughs and a beer.
