Paul T. Barnum, 73, of 5 Fourth St. Towanda, PA passed away Monday evening, April 20, 2015 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Paul was born July 15, 1941 in Sayre, PA the son of John W. Barnum and Gertrude Dunham Barnum. He attended Northeast Bradford High School and subsequently served in the U.S. Army from April 20, 1967 to March 23, 1969 during the Viet Nam War. On July 15, 1972 he married the former Ada French who recently preceded him in death on February 21, 2015. Paul was employed by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in Towanda for over 30 years until his retirement. Paul was an active and dedicated member of the Towanda Fire Department, the LeRaysville-Pike Volunteer Fire Department of which he was a charter member and the Bradford County Fire Police Association for many years. Paul served as vice president of the Pennsylvania Association of Retired Employees Endless Mountains Chapter for several years.
