November 5, 1938 - December 1, 2023

Paul D. Hitchcock, 85, of Wysox, PA passed away Friday, December 1, 2023, at Guthrie Towanda Memorial Hospital in North Towanda Township, PA. Paul was born in Herrick Township, PA on November 5, 1938, the son of Miles B. Hitchcock and Jennie Rose Hotaling Hitchcock.

Paul graduated from Wyalusing High School in 1957 and after graduation he was employed by several farms before enlisting in the Air force in September 1961. Upon completion of basic training he married Louise Kneller on March 3, 1962. He proudly continued his service as a mechanic for four years until he was honorably discharged September 7, 1965.

Following completion of his military service, Paul was employed by the Sardoni Construction Company where he was seriously injured in a construction accident. Upon recovery, he attended Williamsport Community College through rehab services where he graduated as a certified electrician. He was later employed by Stroud's Supply Company in Wysox for many years until his retirement.

Paul enjoyed the outdoors, working around his property, vegetable gardening and playing cards and games with family.

He was a member of the Wysox Presbyterian Church, Roman LeRay Lodge No. 418 F.&A.M., I.O.O.F. Lodge No. 1152, Wysox, and Towanda American Legion Post No. 42.

Paul's family includes his wife, Louise Kneller Hitchcock, their children, Paula Donovan and husband, David, Sandra Cook and husband, Gary, Dale

Hitchcock and wife, Jacey, 7 grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren, brother, Lewis Hitchcock, sister-in-law, Madeline King, as well as several nieces, nephews, and cousins. In addition to his parents, Paul was predeceased by his son, David Duane "Zeke" Hitchcock on April 13, 2023, sister, Bertha Hitchcock, brother, Herbert Hitchcock, sister-in-law, Delores Hitchcock, and brother-in-law, Kenneth King.
