Pauline Strawser of Towanda, age 91, passed away peacefully to live with her Lord on August 18, 2025. She was born as Pauline Haupt on December 21, 1933, in Sunbury, Pennsylvania. As a child and youth, she lived in beautiful Irish Valley. In 1952 she married Fred Strawser. Pauline had a very busy household, bearing four wonderful children in 6 years. Then in 1966 she and her family moved from Sunbury to Towanda. She joined Evergreen Christian Church, where she was an active member for the rest of her life. She was especially active in the Awana program for the church youth. She was well-organized, quick with numbers, and had an impeccable memory. So, in 1983 when H & R Country Store on U.S. 220 came up for sale, she saw an opportunity. For over 35 years under her ownership and management, she offered fishing gear, ammo, Carhart clothes, clothing alterations, and work boots – all at a fair price. But H & R was more than just a store. Because Pauline was the smiling “Good morning!”, the trusted attentive listener, and the giver of level-headed advice. In 2020 she sold the store but continued her many church activities until the very end.

Pauline is survived by brother Jim (Janey) Haupt of Irish Valley; daughter Sue Vegors (Bob) of Jackson, Tennessee; son Fred Strawser (Linda Rebbel) of Bradley Beach, New Jersey; daughter Mrs. Judy Haire of Neath, Pennsylvania; daughter Karen Arnold (Jack) of Frederick, Maryland; 11 grandchildren, and 11 great grandchildren.

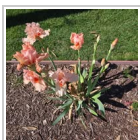
