August 8, 1926 - April 27, 2015

Pearl E. Kimble, age 88, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, April 27, 2015 from her home. She was born August 8, 1926 in Old Forge, NY, the middle of nine children of John and Bertha Helmer Fink.

Pearl spent her early years moving frequently around central New York State, due to her father's work.

Her parents eventually settled in Ilion, NY. On October 12, 1946 she married Wallace Kimble with whom she had 49 ½ years as he predeceased her on February 24, 1996. After one year in New York, the couple with their daughter Barbara moved to a small farm in Luthers Mills, PA. There, three more daughters were born, Mary, Joan and Janet. Pearl would help as needed on the farm but her main focus was that of a homemaker. In 1969 the farm was sold and Pearl and Wally moved to North Towanda, with Wally then working at GTE Sylvania. He retired in 1980 after which they would spend winters in Ocala, FL. It was there that Pearl attended a Baptist church and gave her life to the Lord. Soon following, she became a proud member of the Independent Baptist Church in Towanda which she attended regularly until her death. Pearl and Wally moved to Rome, PA in 1990 and enjoyed a few years there before Wally's health declined and he passed. Though she never thought of herself as a caretaker/nurse she did all she could for her husband. Since his death in 1996 she had kept her home there in the Seven Hills trailer park, thanks to her good neighbors and independent spirit. At age 70 she learned to crochet and made some 800+ lap robes which she gave to the elderly and anyone she

thought might need one. Her other interests were her flowers, inside and out and beautiful, her family, reading (nearly a book a day) especially her Bible, and telling anyone who would listen about her Lord. Pearl will be remembered by those who knew her as being a very energetic, no-nonsense, caring individual determined to the end. She truly was one of a kind. Surviving are: daughters and sons-in-law, Barbara and Jim Warburton, Mary Tyler, Joan and Glenn Shanks, and Janet and Nabil Khalil, grandchildren: Bruce (Sandy) Warburton, Amy (Mike) Calaman, Brian (Eileen) Warburton, Timothy (Sharon) Cobb, Daniel (Querly) Cobb, Kristie (Pedro) Garduno, Mike (Lisa) Shanks, Andy (Kirsten) Shanks, and Tami Shanks, great grandchildren; Blaine and Marshal Warburton, Dylan, T.J., Kasey, Madison, and Jack Cobb, and Lydia, Lincoln, Landon, Kaylee and Josiah Shanks, step great grandchildren, Roxanne (Dustin) Allen, Rachel, Robyn, Daniel and Katelyn Calaman. In addition to her parents and husband, Pearl was predeceased by infant twin daughters, five sisters and three brothers. A celebration of Pearl's life will be held Friday, May 1, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. at the Independent Baptist Church, Towanda with Pastors Donn Hauser, Mike Shanks and Andy Shanks officiating. Interment will be in Bradford County Memorial Park, Burlington Township, PA.
