Phyllis Murray Cochi, 87, of 203 N. Wilbur Ave. Sayre, PA passed away Saturday evening May 4, 2013 at her home surrounded by her loving family. Phyllis was born July 10, 1925 in Waverly, NY the daughter of Michael and Helen VanHorn Murray. She was a graduate of Waverly High School class of 1944. While attending high school she was employed by the Sugar Bowl in Waverly. In early years, Phyllis was employed by the Remington-Rand in Elmira and by the Keystone Inn in Sayre.

On July 10th 1952 she married Arnold L. Cochi at Saint James Church in Waverly. She was preceded in death by her husband of 58 years on October 18, 2010.
