She was extremely proud of her garden, and would proudly share when her fruit trees or bushes were “loaded” with fruit. She chopped and hauled her own firewood until she physically could not – much later in life than people would have thought.

Priscilla was an active member of the senior communities in Sayre, Waverly and Nichols, going on senior trips, playing bingo and attending church. She enjoyed Tioga Downs and their buffet as well as other local eateries, especially Fortune Buffet.

Affectionately known as “Baba” to her grandchildren and “Pra-baba” to her great grandchildren, she cherished family visits, where she would host tea parties and treat her family to special desserts. A visit would typically include a trip to Aldi’s to select their own treats.
