Ralph S. Park II, 68, of 12 5th St, Towanda PA, passed away Friday, July 27, 2012. Born in Towanda, PA on June 29, 1944 he was the son of Ralph S. Park and Agnes Pitts Park of Monroeton.

Ralph was a graduate of Towanda High School, class of 1962, and a graduate of Penn State Hazleton, class of 1965, with an associate degree in engineering electrical and electronic technology. He earned his professional engineer certificate in 1982.

He was employed at Claverack Electric Company for 34 years as the director of the engineering department.

Ralph was a member of the Towanda Water Board, a life member of the Towanda Gun club, a Social member of the Towanda VFW, life member of Towanda Elks Lodge #2191, and Past Master of Evergreen Lodge #163, F. & A.M. of Pennsylvania. When he was younger, he earned his Eagle Scout award.
